While working at this project, I will:

- Not be under the influence or in possession of illicit drugs or liquor.
- Act in a manner that is respectable.
- Not bring weapons, children, and animals.
- Only use mobile devices/radios for jobsite communication purposes (no music players).
- Report to work in a healthy and rested condition.
- Follow no smoking rules.
- Treat portable restrooms with respect.
- Report graffiti to Sundt management.
- Immediately report incidents (injuries, near misses, equipment/property damage, spills) to the Sundt Superintendent.
- Immediately report any unsafe or unsanitary conditions to supervision or the Sundt Superintendent. If possible, correct the condition first, and then report. Do not work in the area until the hazard has been corrected.
- Clean up liquid spills immediately.
- Report all defective equipment to supervision.
- Wear 100% eye and hand protection.
- Follow OSHA/manufacturer PPE requirements.
- Wear High-visibility clothing.
- Wear a face shield while grinding.
- Have a hot work permit in place before generating a spark or flame.
- Control dust-generating activities (i.e., silica/concrete dust) with wet, vacuum, or other approved and planned methods.
- Wear professional attire and sleeved shirts (no loose or frayed clothing, sweatpants, shorts, or badly worn shoes).
- Wear a nonconductive hard hat.
- Wear a seat belt when provided.
- Conduct a 360 walk around prior to operating a vehicle or mobile equipment.
- Tether, secure, or protect elevated tools and materials to prevent dropped objects.

- Prevent materials, tools, or other objects from being thrown or falling from buildings/structures.
- Only enter safe and protected excavations.
- Have a Disturbance Permit and Daily Excavation Log for excavation work as required.
- Have a pick plan in place for hoisting activities.
- Use fall protection for potential fall exposures of 6 feet or greater including excavations and ladders used next to openings.
- Maintain guardrails, barricades, and danger/caution tape.
- Install, secure, label and maintain covers on floor, deck, manhole, and roof openings.
- Use a full-body harness and restraint lanyard or self-retracting lanyard in boom lifts.
- Secure my scissor lift's chain/door/gate.
- Only use nonconductive ladders.
- Ensure the competent person documents scaffold inspections and tags scaffolding to communicate the status.
- Only work with electrical wiring, equipment, or machinery if I am trained and qualified to do so.
- Ensure corded equipment is grounded and GFCI protected.
- Remove damaged cords from service and tag as defective. Elevate or protect cords as practicable.
- Follow lockout / tagout procedures.
- Ensure confined spaces are identified/labeled.
- Ensure adequate air testing and training prior to entering a confined space.
- Ensure a permit is completed prior to entering a permit-required confined space.
- Comply with hazardous material regulations.
- Practice relentless housekeeping at all times.
- Follow jobsite speed limits.
- Know where emergency exits, fire extinguishers, and first aid kits are located.
- Know emergency action steps and contacts.
- Sign off on a Task Hazard Analysis before starting a new task or activity.**
